Dear Representatives Quigley, Meehan:

On behalf of the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association (www.fleoa.org), the nation's largest non-partisan association representing federal law enforcement officers, we wanted express our strong support for the NICS Denial Notification Act of 2016.

The NCIS Denial Notification Act would establish an alert system to notify state and local law enforcement authorities whenever a suspected prohibited person attempts to purchase a firearm. Currently, state and local law enforcement departments in 35 states do not routinely receive such notifications from the federal government. By informing state and local police whenever a prohibited person attempts to purchase a firearm, they can choose to initiate criminal investigations, pursue criminal charges, or conduct surveillance. The purchase of firearms by prohibited individuals poses a consequential risk to public safety, and this bill will help keep communities safer from the ever increasing violence.

While no one-gun law is the magical fix to gun violence, this bill represents a common-sense approach. We all have a responsibility to keep our nation and communities safe, and FLEOA is proud to stand next to our local and state counterparts in combating this insidious crime.
